Section VIII – BSAA STUDENT MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

TC.1 By submitting the attached application and in consideration for this application, Applicant agrees to the following terms and conditions:

TC.2 Sections I to VII are incorporated herein by reference. Applicants are cautioned that acceptance of their application entails an obligation to pay BLACK SPORTS AGENTS ASSOCIATION (BSAA) annual membership dues of \$195.00, which may increase if said student member wishes to continue membership after graduating from his/her schooling. The annual amount to be paid by accepted BSAA STUDENT MEMBERS is not refundable for any reason.

TC.3 Applicant acknowledges that Applicant is in no way guaranteed to be approved as a BSAA Student Member, nor is it guaranteed that modifications will or will not be made to the annual BSAA Student Membership fee.

TC.4 Applicant asserts that all information to BSAA is true and accurate, and that any misrepresentation is grounds for immediate rejection of the Applicant's application or termination of Applicant's BSAA Student Membership. Applicant agrees to notify BSAA of any changes to Applicant's personal information.

TC.5 Applicant asserts that it has the full power and authority necessary to submit this application.

TC.6 By submitting this application, Applicant agrees to the collection, use, and processing of the personal information Applicant provides to BSAA. The data collected will be used for business and administrative purposes, which include but are not limited to, processing Applicant's annual dues, assessing member qualifications, and other general uses at the discretion of BSAA

TC.7 Applicant asserts that the submission of this application will not (i) conflict with the certificate of incorporation, by-laws or other applicable governing document of Applicant, (ii) conflict with, or result in the breach or termination of, or constitute a default under, any lease, agreement, commitment or other agreement or instrument, or any order, judgment or decree to which Applicant is a party or by which Applicant is bound, or (iii) constitute a violation by Applicant of any applicable law or regulation, or require Applicant to obtain or make any consent, waiver, approval, order, permit or authorization.

TC.8 Applicant waives all claims or other legal recourse against BSAA arising from or related to the application process, to the full extent allowed by law.

TC.9. Applicant understands and agrees that nothing in this Application or release shall be construed to create a partnership or any other entity or business venture between BSAA and the applicant and/or the applicant's business enterprise/company or corporation;

TC.10 Applicant agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless BSAA., from and against, any and all claims, demands, liabilities, costs and/or expenses (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees) brought against, paid or incurred by BSAA, at any time and in any way resulting from, arising out of, or otherwise relating to Applicant's application to become a BSAA Student Member, including any alleged or actual gross negligence or knowing and willful misconduct by applicant. In no event shall BSAA be liable to Applicant for indirect, incidental, consequential, special or exemplary damage or expense, including without limitation, lost profits or opportunity costs, even if BSAA have been advised of the possibility of such damage or expense.

TC.11 Arbitration in California. Any dispute or claim arising or related to this Agreement, its performance, breach, or interpretation (including issues about its validity or enforceability), shall be exclusively (except as provided below) resolved by final binding arbitration before the American Arbitration Association (AAA), utilizing its Commercial Arbitration Rules. One arbitrator shall be selected using AAA procedures. The arbitrator shall use all reasonable efforts to minimize discovery and to complete the arbitration proceedings as expeditiously as possible. The Arbitrator shall render a written decision within thirty (30) calendar days of the hearing. The arbitrator will not award attorney's fees, or punitive, incidental, consequential, treble or other

multiple or exemplary damages, and the parties hereby agree to waive and not seek such damages. Either party may seek judicial relief to compel the other party to comply with the provisions of this Section, or injunctive or other equitable relief to protect its intellectual property rights, provided (unless prohibited by applicable law) that the remainder of the dispute or claim is submitted to arbitration. The arbitration shall be held in Los Angeles, California; both parties hereby give their irrevocable consent to jurisdiction of courts of or in the State of California, as well as processes of the AAA in California. Awards shall be final, binding and non-appealable (except on the minimal grounds required under the Federal Arbitration Act or other applicable law). All awards may be filed with one or more courts, state, federal or foreign having jurisdiction over the party against whom such award is rendered or its property, as a basis of judgment and of the issuance of execution for its collection.

TC.12 Governing Law. This Agreement shall be deemed made in, governed by, performed in, and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of California, U.S.A., without giving effect to its conflicts of laws provisions or principles.

TC.13 As a member of the BSAA Student Membership Program, Applicant agrees to take personal responsibility for Applicant's individual conduct, and agrees to abide by and promote the principles contained in the BSAA Student Membership "Pledge" and any governing documents and policies of BSAA. Applicant's failure to adhere to the BSAA "Pledge" shall be grounds for denial or termination of Applicant's BSAA Student Membership.

TC.14 Applicant agrees to refrain from any form of illegal, unethical, or irresponsible behavior, including, but not limited to, harassment, defamation, fraud, and wavering integrity. If Applicant chooses to engage in such conduct, Applicant understands that he/his may be responsible to reimburse BSAA and other BSAA affiliates involved, the residual damages, losses, or costs associated with Applicant's negligent conduct.
